### Management Discussion of Fund Performance

#### Results of Operations

The Fund commenced operations in March of 2015. During the six-month ended June 30, 2017, the Fund issued 1,221 Series A shares, 963 Series F shares and 150,730 Series G shares and redeemed 34,495 Series A shares, 53,881 Series F shares and 626,056 Series G shares. As at June 30, 2017, 21,366 Series A shares, 34,061 Series F shares and 145,424 Series G shares were outstanding. During the six-month period ended June 30, 2017, the Fund realized an accounting gain of \$634,464 from disposition of securities.

For the six-month ended, the Fund earned dividend income of \$11,000. Total expenses before expense reimbursement was \$135,000 comprised mainly of \$37,000 in shareholder recordkeeping and fund accounting fees, \$19,000 in audit fees, \$18,000 in transaction costs, \$17,000 in legal fees, \$11,000 in management fees (calculated daily at an annual rate of 2.0% of the NAV of Series A shares, 1.0% of the NAV of Series F shares and 0.60% of the NAV of Series G shares), \$11,000 in filing fees and \$8,000 in custodial fees.

Net realized gains are \$634,464 for the six-month ended June 30, 2017 and net realized losses are \$365,902 for the six-month ended June 30, 2016. Unrealized depreciation of investments was \$430,444 for the six-month period ended June 30, 2017 and unrealized appreciation was \$402,117 for the six-month period ended June 30, 2016.

At June 30, 2017, net assets attributable to holders of redeemable shares for Series A shares was \$223,996 or \$10.48 per share, for Series F shares was \$365,739 or \$10.74 per share, and for Series G shares was \$1,720,800 or \$11.83 per share.

#### Recent Developments

At a special meeting of shareholders of the Fund held on December 21, 2016 the voting shareholders approved the change in the Fund’s fundamental investment objective “to provide long-term capital appreciation by investing primarily in equity securities of Canadian and foreign companies”. The change in fundamental investment objective and strategies change the Fund’s investment strategy category from “Canadian Small Cap Equity” to “Canadian Focused Equity”, a category that carries a lower risk profile. Specifically, the Fund’s risk rating will change from “Medium to High” to “Medium”.

The Fund had also changed its name from “AlphaDelta Canadian Prosperity Class” to “AlphaDelta Canadian Focused Equity Class”.

The change in fundamental investment objective and the name change became effective December 30, 2016.

#### Related Party Transactions

Pursuant to the amended and restated master management agreement, the Manager is entitled to an annual management fee of 2.0% of the net asset value of Series A shares, 1.0% of the net asset value of Series F shares of the Fund and 0.60% of the net asset value of Series G shares of the Fund, calculated daily and payable monthly in arrears. For the six-month ended June 30, 2017, the Fund incurred \$11,389 in management fees of which \$1,827 was payable at June 30, 2017.

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In order for the Fund to maintain a competitive position with other mutual funds with respect to operating expenses charged to the Fund, AlphaDelta Management Corp. (“AlphaDelta”), an affiliate of Qwest Investment Fund Management Ltd. (the “Manager”), has agreed at its discretion to pay for some of the operating expenses of the Fund. AlphaDelta has absorbed a total of \$83,549 of the operating expenses of the Fund for the six-month period ended June 30, 2017.

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

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### Past Performance
